PHP LOOKING BACK AND LOOKING AHEAD

LOOKING BACK

It's already a month into the new year 2024! People Helping People is moving forward to make 2024 an even better year of helping our community than 2023 was. That may be a tough one though. Here is a quick synopsis or what we were able to do for those in need in Hernando County because of YOU!

- Our Sunday Blessings program served over 3500 dinners to the homeless and low income individuals and families, including lunches twice a week
- Our Neighborhood Blessings program delivered nearly 2000 bags of food and hot meals to the homeless in the area
- Our Senior Blessings program provided close to 2000 bags of supplemental food pantry items to low income seniors
- ◆ Through our partnering with Feeding Tampa Bay for our Mobile Food Distribution on the last Wednesday of every month, we placed 6000 boxes of food (produce, meats, baked good, breads, snacks) in the trunks of cars of those in our community struggling to put food on their table
- Our Health Clinic provided healthcare to 175 uninsured people people who
 would have either gone untreated, ended up in the emergency room,
 or worse.......
- We shared more than 10,000 pounds of food each month through our feeding programs
- We provided a comfortable place for AA to hold its meetings during the weeknights, bringing support to those in or seeking recovery
- GED classes were held here throughout the school year in partnership with the Hernando School District. Additionally, PHP offered scholarships to attend for qualifying individuals
- ♦ Nature Coast Art League met here weekly, a gathering place to meet the social and creative needs of seniors
- PHP handed out tents, tarps, blankets, and toiletries to those in need (even pet food donated by local veterinarians for hungry animals)
- ♦ We offered a place for the homeless to take showers twice a week
- ♦ We helped fill out forms for SNAP, IDs, unemployment, social security
- ♦ We provided a few hours of refuge and coffee to anyone
- We listened to so many sad and tragic stories, offering hope when we could or at least a shoulder to lean or cry on
- We learned the names of people who frequent our HELP Center and sometimes just wanted to be around others
- We were incremental in establishing the Hernando Homeless Initiative, hosting the first ever
 Day of Hope for the homeless at our Kass Circle HELP Center

We did this all while being almost 100% volunteer-driven
