You may wonder what would be the thinking behind a very busy business man (he owns two businesses!) wanting to become a board member of a non profit organization and then not soon after, take over the role of president of that board.

As of July 1, Burton Melaugh was unanimously approved by fellow board members of People Helping People to be its president.

It was easy for him to accept the role because of his strong support of PHP's mission - to alleviate hunger in Hernando County.

Burton and his wife Nita run a catering business. They feel there should be no reason for anyone in the US to go hungry. The tragedy of people not having enough to eat was simply unacceptable to him without his doing something to help. With that, Burton became one a PHP board member, feeling both empowered and expecting "to hop in the trenches and do the work".



Burton goes on, "Our board is not for those who'd like to simply attend once a month and make decisions. Along with being very diligent, the PHP Board

harbors no personal agendas. It's always about the cause and is the reason we work so well together.

There's never any 'me' or 'I' at People Helping

People, therefore, no effort is wasted as we direct our services toward those less fortunate."

Burton has stated his goal as PHP president is to empower its executive director and board members to flourish all their inclinations and abilities as PHP continues to grow.

"We've an ambitious plan to court more funding and expand our program offerings, and it's my job to ensure that our plans and growth are well organized.

As we know, great ideas remain dreams without subsequent and comprehensive planning,

implementation, and execution."

Originally from Manhattan, Burton moved to Winter Park, FL, in '78, entered in the Marines, and fought in Desert Storm. After later graduating from FSU, he started working in the restaurant and catering business and then moved to Dade City to take care of his grandmother. There he opened a small takeout and catering place. Burton says joining the Chamber of Commerce was one of the best decisions he made as it lead to his marrying its director Nita. They ultimately settled in Hernando County where together they own Betty Marie's Catering and Blue Mountain Web Designs.

You'll often find Burton helping others every chance he gets because for him "it's life's greatest joy."

Easy Recipes

From Food Pantry Items

Here's a recipe that can be made using simple pantry items -
Pasta Tuna Salad.

- 1 box (12 oz) pasta
- 1 can (10 oz) tuna
- 1 can (15 oz) green beans
- 1 ½ cups mayonnaise

1. Cook and drain pasta of your choice
2. Drain and rinse the green beans (cut to desired size if necessary)
3. Drain, rinse, and separate tuna chunks
4. Add the green beans, tuna, and mayonnaise to the pasta, using only enough mayonnaise to make the salad creamy
5. Add desired amount of salt and pepper
6. Stir well
7. Chill for an hour before serving
