ON BEING HOMELESS IN HERNANDO

This is a real and honest perspective of what it's like to be homeless in Hernando County......

Some of you may have seen them. A man pushing an older woman in a wheelchair up and down Spring Hill Drive. David and his mother Patricia.

They had been renting a home in the area, but the owner wanted to renovate and sell the house. They were given a short time frame to vacate but were unable to find any place they could afford (sound familiar?). David and Patty came to PHP to see what help they could find. For months, we tried to find them housing, to no avail. For months, we fed them, shared potential resources, and provided a safe, cool place to stay during the day. Ahhh. But the nights. The harsh, dark, humid nights....David doesn't want to disclose exactly where, but the two of them slept on concrete seven nights a week. They avoided the woods because of the drugs and safety concerns. They tried staying outside of churches, but security would chase them off the property. If they could just find safe shelter, David could look for work and not worry about leaving his mother alone and unattended. Patty received a small amount from social security each month and SNAP funds but this didn't allow for them to pay rent.

David describes his experience seeking help in Hernando as challenging and stressful. "I plowed through every nonprofit and other organizations. Government agencies and all the churches not only in Hernando but neighboring counties as well. There was no help." David finally reached out to distant family out of state who put him and his mom up in a motel until they pulled enough money to get David and Patty's belongings (what was left) out of storage and drove them to Georgia to stay with family members. What David would like people in Hernando to know. "Honestly, get help from friends and family, not any government agency. They might have the money but realistically they help themselves over the people that vote them in office. Churches are strapped for funds and other means to help.

Life is getting better little by little. Being in a new state, things takes time."
