## Ron Van Matre Steps Down

After 11 years at People Helping People (PHP), Ron Van Matre is retiring.

Back in 2009, when PHP was founded, Ron served briefly on the board and became the executive director for the nonprofit. In addition to being an unpaid executive director for over nine years, Ron assumed the responsibility of getting meals for PHP's Sunday Blessings program. Ron would contact restaurants, civic organizations and individuals to provide a Sunday meal for up to 150 people. In a year's time, he typically would fill 50 of the 52 weeks of the year.

Additionally, Ron headed up the food drives program for donated can goods and nonperishable food. He made arrangements for food drives by contacting organizations and businesses to ask their employees or members to donate food for the hungry. Also, he put together a team for pickup and delivery of the food to our warehouse, which is now at the HELP Center.

After we hired a paid executive director, Ron continued on as a board and executive board member. He has been a tireless volunteer, as well as a financial contributor to PHP. Already, we had to recruit several volunteers to carry out the jobs that he filled for PHP.
